Welcome

It's been another eventful year for the legal industry, but with restrictions now fully eased across the UK it's our hope that the rest of 2022 will look a lot brighter for those working in the industry.

In this report, we've taken a look back at 2021 to examine the salaries on offer for the roles advertised on Simply Law. We've also compared last year's salaries to those on offer in 2020, to see how the market changed throughout these two years.

Happily, it seems that most of the major job roles on Simply Law saw an increase in salary from 2020 to 2021, with some roles seeing their average salary almost double. With the economic uncertainty that 2022 has brought so far, it's difficult to predict how much salaries will grow over the next 12 months, although we're hopeful that the number of job openings on offer will continue to grow.

We hope this report provides you with some wider industry context about wages that may be of some help to you in your own job search.



Highest paid roles in 2021


